The Atlanta, GA chapter was first incorporated in March 1954 as *The Georgia Retired Officers Association, Inc.* In December 1959, the chapter's name was transferred to become the Georgia state umbrella organization. The local chapter was reincorporated as the *Atlanta Metropolitan Retired Officers Association* and became affiliated with *The Retired Officers Association* in July 1960. In January 2003, when TROA became MOAA, the chapter name was again changed to the *Atlanta Chapter of the Military Officers Association of America, Inc.* and became an affiliate of MOAA.

The chapter includes members from all the counties of the greater metropolitan Atlanta area and is associated with Dobbins Air Reserve Base.

The chapter meets monthly (except July and August) at a time and place announced in our newsletter.

**Who is eligible for membership?**

Actively serving, retired, or former commissioned or warrant officers of the uniformed services of the USA (Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, Public Health Service, and National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration) and their surviving spouses may be members of MOAA and/or its affiliated chapters.

**Does membership in MOAA make me a member of the Atlanta Chapter? NO.**

You must also join the chapter and pay its annual dues.

**Is attendance at membership meetings mandatory? NO.**

You may participate online, serve as a Legislative or JROTC liaison, or as a Veterans Treatment Court mentor without attending meetings. But we hope you do.
